Art students continued working on their various projects...Community projects, optical illusions, pinch pots and lids, still life drawings...

All of the students also worked in their Sketch-N-Write Journals. I've given each student a journal which they use from 2nd - 6th grade, for a variety of entries.

After completing a project, students draw an example of the project as well as the vocabulary words they've learned from the assignment. When doing an artist's study, they write facts they've learned about the person and their work and they draw an example of their artwork.

Other entries include the sequence of steps used for a project, so students can re-create a project on their own in the future. Students also use the journal for "Free Art", which means they can draw a picture of whatever they want and they do "Free Writing" beneath the picture.

These journals are sent home with the students when they graduate in 6th grade, so that they have a collection of their artwork from their years at Grady. :)

During the final week of December, a variety of art supplies were presented to the students so they could have the opportunity to make a creation of their own choosing!
