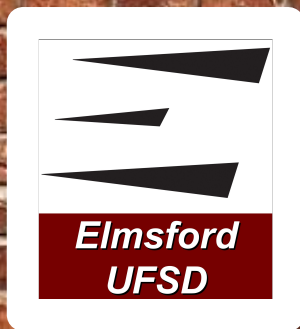

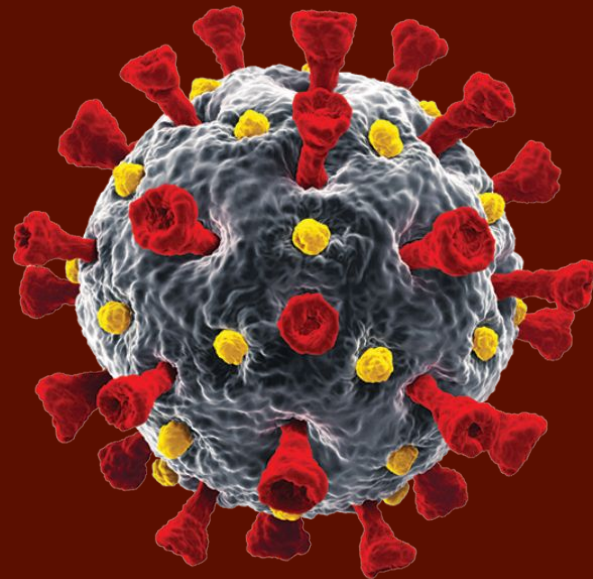

COVID-19 Screening Attestation

The safety of the employees, students, families, clients, partners and visitors remains our top priority. As the COVID-19 outbreak continues, we will closely monitor the situation and will periodically update our guidance based on current recommendations from New York State.

Based on currently available information and clinical expertise, older adults and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions (e.g. serious heart disease, chronic lung disease or asthma, immunocompromised, severe liver disease, etc.) might be at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19. If you are concerned about underlying medical conditions, please consult with your personal medical health care provider.

To prevent the spread of COVID-19 and reduce the potential risk of exposure to our workforce, we are conducting a simple screening. Your participation is important to help us take precautionary measures to protect you and everyone in this facility. We request you complete this screening everyday prior to entering a facility. Based on your response, you will be informed if you should report to work or if you can enter our facilities.

1. Since your last day of work, or last visit home, have you had any of these symptoms?

- ☐ Cough
- ☐ Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

- ☐ Muscle pain
- ☐ Headache
- ☐ Sore throat
- ☐ New loss of taste or smell
- ☐ Gastrointestinal tract symptoms (generally affecting children only)

3. Have you had close contact with a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19 case within 14 days?

4. Have you traveled internationally or been in a state with widespread community transmission of COVID-19 per the New York State Travel Advisory in the past 14 days?

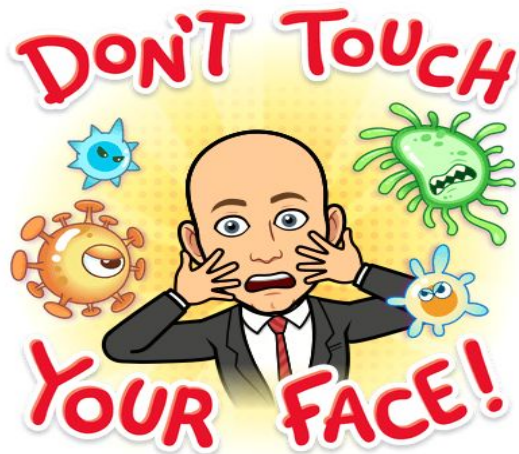





FIVE WAYS TO STOP THE SPREAD

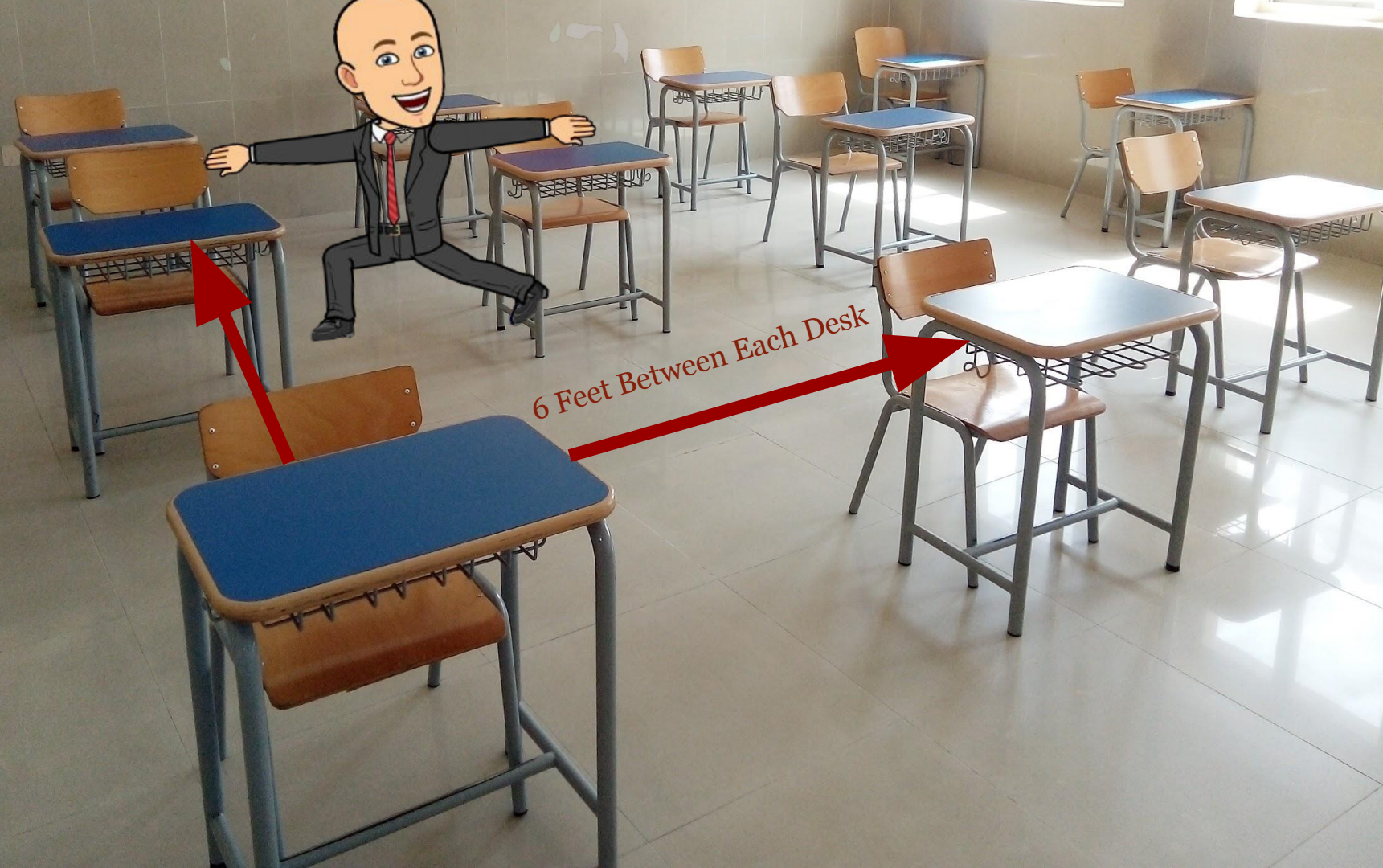

Social Distancing

- ✓ Pursuant to NYSDOH Guidance - appropriate social distancing (i.e. 6 feet/barriers)
- ✓ As a baseline, face coverings are required when individuals cannot maintain appropriate social distancing.
- ✓ Face coverings are “strongly recommended” by the NYDOH at all times, except for meals and instruction with appropriate social distancing.
- ✓ In our schools we require face coverings at all times, even during instruction (except during mask breaks)

NYSDOH COVID-19 In-Person Decision Making Flowchart for Student Attendance

Can My Child Go To School Today?

In the past 10 days, has your child been tested for the virus that causes COVID-19, also known as SARS-CoV-2?

YES

Was the test result **positive** OR are you still waiting for the result?

YES

Your child **cannot** go to school today.
They must stay in Isolation (at home and away from others) until the test results are back and are **negative** OR if **positive**, the local health department has released your child from Isolation.

NO

In the last 14 days, has your child:

- Traveled internationally to a [CDC level 2 or 3 COVID-19 related travel health notice country](#); or
- Traveled to a state or territory on the [NYS Travel Advisory List](#); or
- Been designated a contact of a person who tested positive for COVID-19 by a local health department?

YES

Your child **cannot** go to school today.
They must stay at home until your local health department releases your child from quarantine, at least 14 days.
A negative diagnostic COVID-19 test does not change the 14-day quarantine requirement.

NO

Does your child currently have (or has had in the last 10 days) one or more of these new or worsening symptoms?

- A temperature greater than or equal to 100.0° F (37.8° C)
- Feel feverish or have chills
- Cough
- Loss of taste or smell
- Fatigue/feeling of tiredness
- Sore throat
- Shortness of breath or trouble breathing
- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea
- Muscle pain or body aches
- Headaches
- Nasal congestion/runny nose

YES

Your child **cannot** go to school today.
Your child should be assessed by their pediatric healthcare provider (HCP). Call your child's HCP before going to the office or clinic to tell them about your child's COVID-19 symptoms. If your child does not have a HCP, call your local health department.

NO

Your child **CAN** go to school today.
Make sure they wear a face covering or face mask, practice social distancing, and wash their hands!

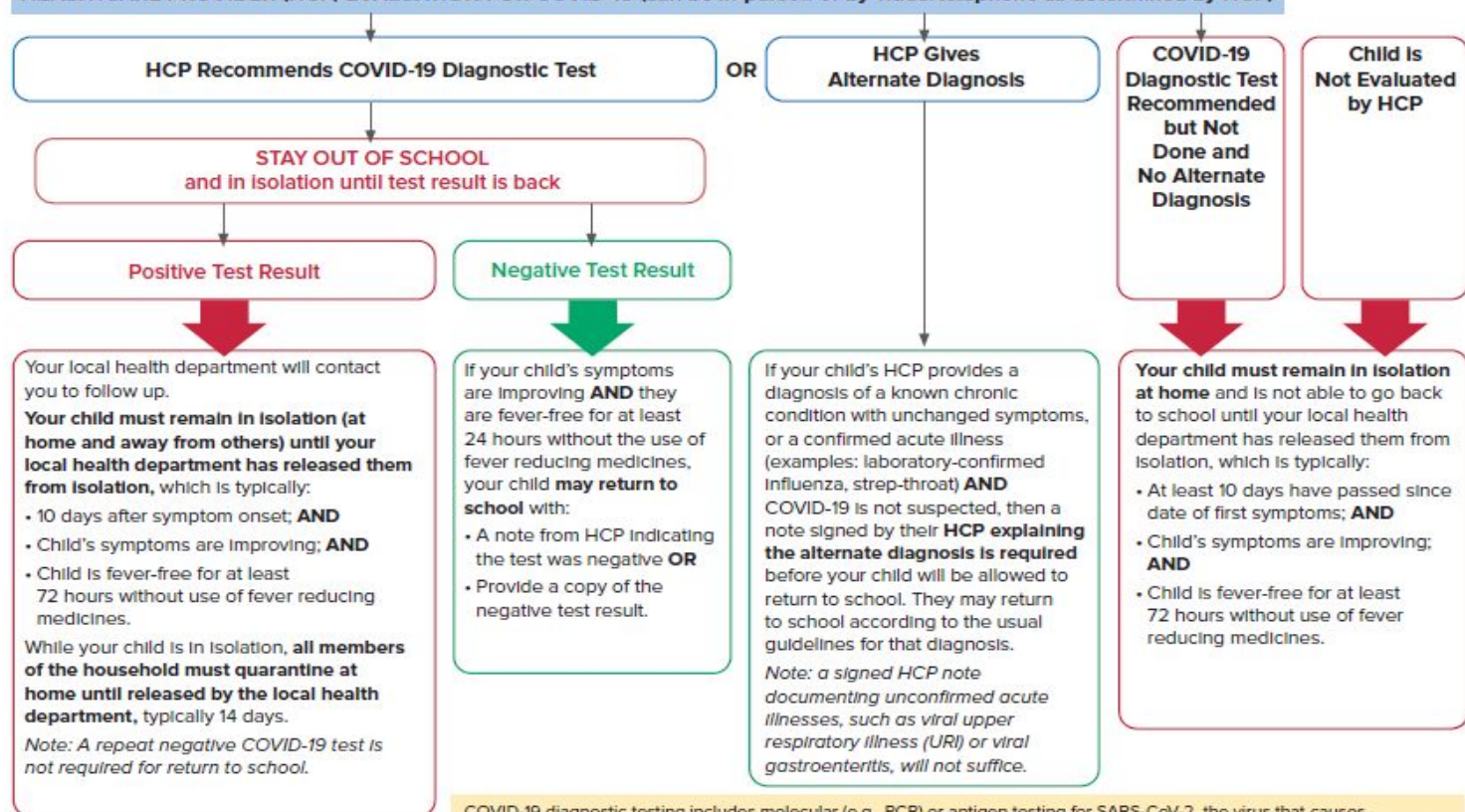
Report absences, symptoms, and positive COVID-19 test results to your child's school.

SEEK IMMEDIATE MEDICAL CARE IF YOUR CHILD HAS:

- Trouble breathing or is breathing very quickly
- Prolonged fever
- Is too sick to drink fluids
- Severe abdominal pain, diarrhea or vomiting
- Change in skin color - becoming pale, patchy and/or blue
- Racing heart or chest pain
- Decreased urine output
- Lethargy, irritability, or confusion

My child has COVID-19 symptoms. When can they go back to school?

HEALTHCARE PROVIDER (HCP) EVALUATION FOR COVID-19 (can be in-person or by video/telephone as determined by HCP)



COVID-19 diagnostic testing includes molecular (e.g., PCR) or antigen testing for SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19. Diagnostic testing may be performed with a nasopharyngeal swab, nasal swab, or saliva sample, as ordered by the health care provider and per laboratory specifications. At times, a negative antigen test will need to be followed up with a confirmatory molecular test. Serology (antibody testing) cannot be used to rule in or out acute COVID-19.

Exactly the same each week (Except Holidays). Students do NOT change days.



Learning Models



What Is Synchronous Learning?

- Synchronous learning happens during the cohort's in-person days (regardless if a student is remote)
- Students and teachers interact in a specific virtual place at a set time.
- Common methods of synchronous online learning include in-person learning, Google Meets, live chatting, and live-streamed lessons that must be viewed in real time.



Learning Models



What is Asynchronous Learning?

- Asynchronous learning is student/parent managed.
- Teachers will provide materials and assignments
- Flexible schedule to complete the assignment
- Common methods of asynchronous virtual learning - modules, pre-recorded lessons, virtual libraries, and online discussion boards or social media platforms.
- Each school/classroom will vary, so questions may be directed toward your child's teacher

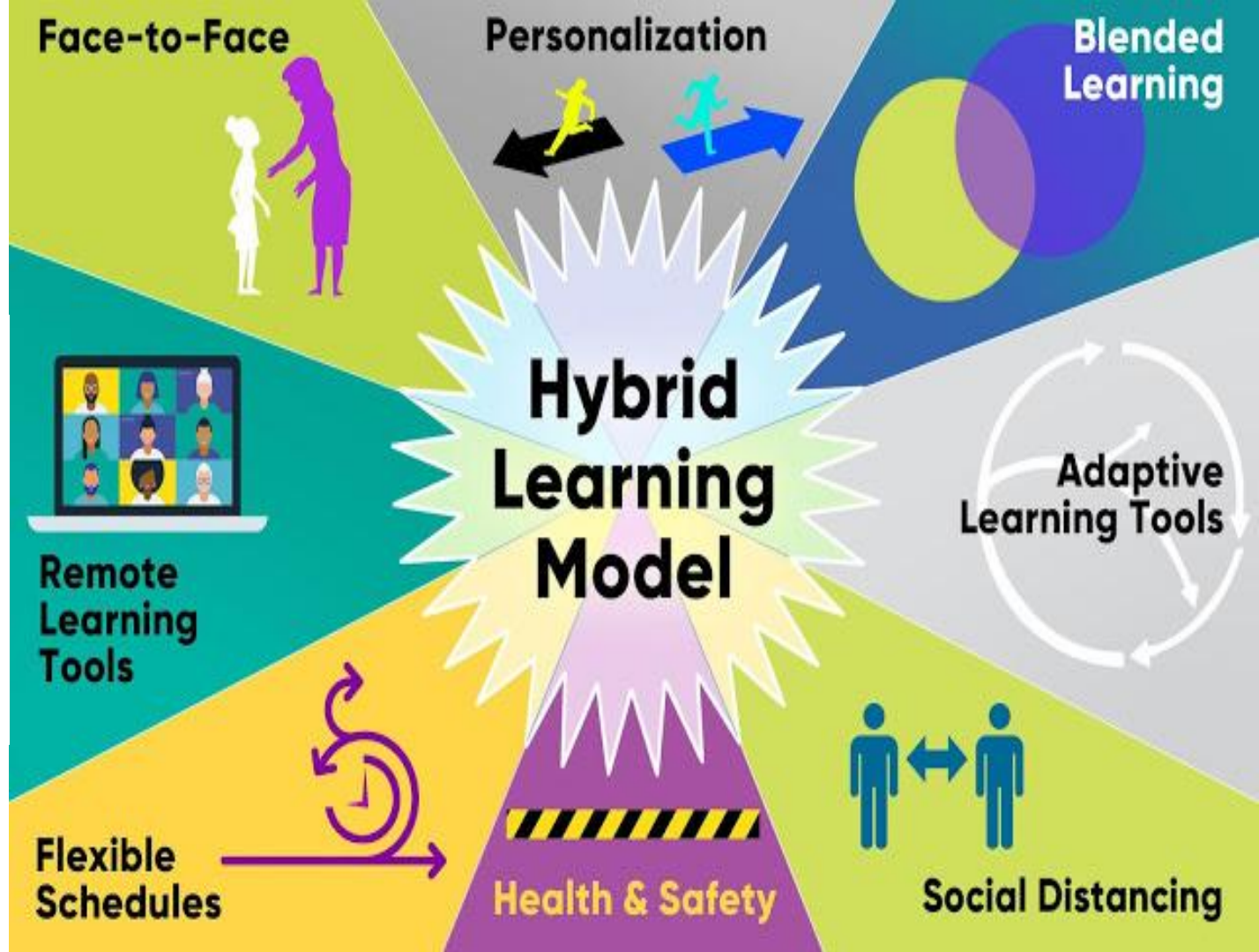


Learning Models



What may I expect on Wednesdays?

- All students are 100% Virtual
- Teachers may meet with students in both A & B cohorts together
- Teachers will provide materials and assignments (synchronous and asynchronous)
- Teachers may provide academic interventions and enrichment opportunities
- Flexible schedule to complete the assignment
- Each school/classroom will vary, so questions may be directed toward your child's teacher





Attendance Process

- Daily attendance is required each day for all students, whether in person or 100% Remote
 - ✓ Dixon/Grady - Attendance is taken in homeroom
 - ✓ Hamilton - In-person (in class)/Virtual (Google Form)
- Daily attendance varies by building (please contact your child's principal with questions)

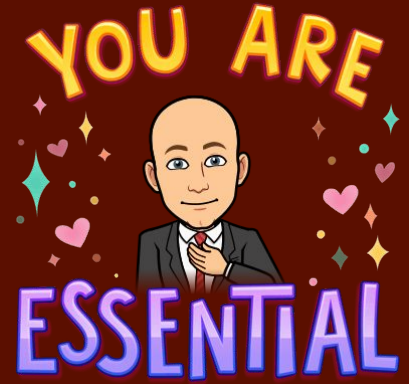
